Health Precautions at Mass

Out of an abundance of caution, we will be making the following changes at Mass for the time being.

- 1. We have hand sanitizer at the entrances to the church and encourage everyone to use it as they enter the church. Our supply of hand sanitizer is limited, so consider bringing your own to use.
- 2. We are suspending the distribution of Holy Communion from the chalice. This is not only for the health of everyone receiving Communion, but also the EMs and priest who drink from the chalices after everyone else.
- 3. We are suspending the sign of peace. The sign of peace is optional at Mass.
- 4. We discourage people from holding hands during the Our Father. Holding hands during the Our Father is actually not a prescribed posture anyway.
- 5. We encourage anyone who feels ill or has a cough to stay home.

 People who are ill are not obligated to attend Mass.
