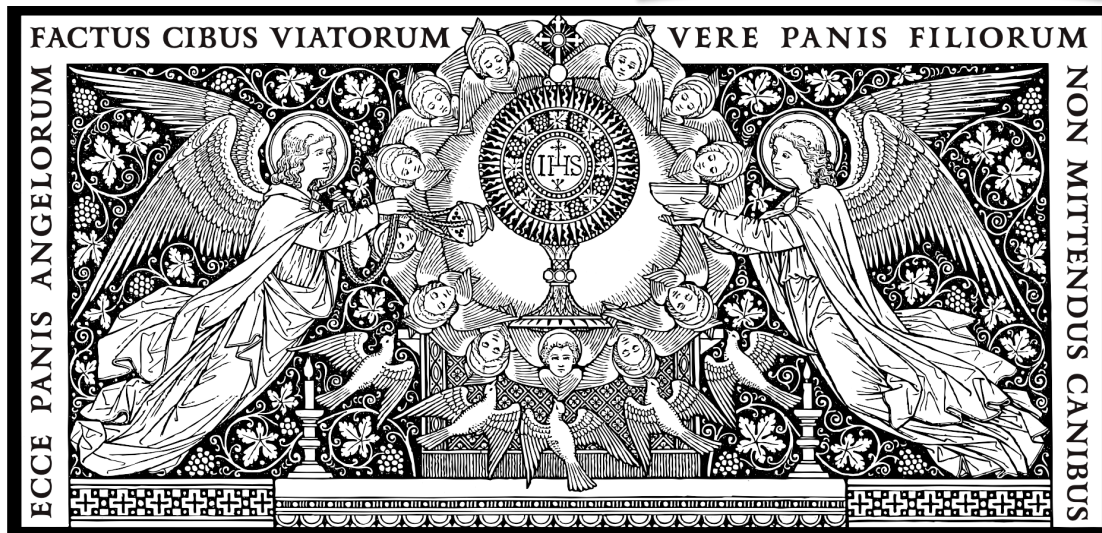
### Bulletin Announcements
