We will send out urgent information, like when Mass is canceled due to weather or some other circumstance.

If you belong to a special group, like the altar society, religious education, youth group, lectors and EMHCs, a bible study, etc, you can receive information specific to that group. You can make these selections when you sign up.

We promise not to bombard you with unnecessary information. And you can adjust your communication preferences on your own at any time.
