### *A New Priest*

On Saturday, June 1, a new priest will be ordained to the priesthood for our diocese. Deacon Jacob Jaks will be ordained at 10:00am CT, at the Cathedral of the Sacred Heart in Pensacola.

The evening prior, at 5:00pm CT, there will be a celebration of solemn Vespers and chalice blessing in prayerful anticipation of the installation and ordination of Deacon Jacob Jaks to the priesthood by Bishop Wack. The eve of the Ordination Mass is a significant time for prayer. All are invited to Solemn Vespers and the Ordination Mass. A reception will follow Jacob's ordination in Ave Maria Hall.
