Every Friday during Lent we will have the Stations of the Cross at 6:00pm, followed by a soup/meatless supper in the parish hall.

### *Health Precautions at Mass*

Out of an abundance of caution, we will be making the following changes at Mass for the time being.

1. **We have hand sanitizer at the entrances to the church** and encourage everyone to use it as they enter the church. Our supply of hand sanitizer is limited, so consider bringing your own to use.
2. **We are suspending the distribution of Holy Communion from the chalice.** This is not only for the health of everyone receiving Communion, but also the EMs and priest who drink from the chalices after everyone else.
3. **We are suspending the sign of peace.** The sign of peace is optional at Mass.
4. **We discourage people from holding hands during the Our Father.** Holding hands during the Our Father is actually not a prescribed posture anyway.
5. **We encourage anyone who feels ill or has a cough to stay home.** People who are ill are not obligated to attend Mass.
