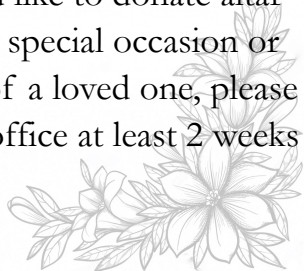

Gospel Reflection
