Next Week's Second Collection

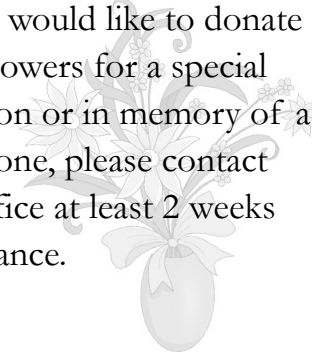
