

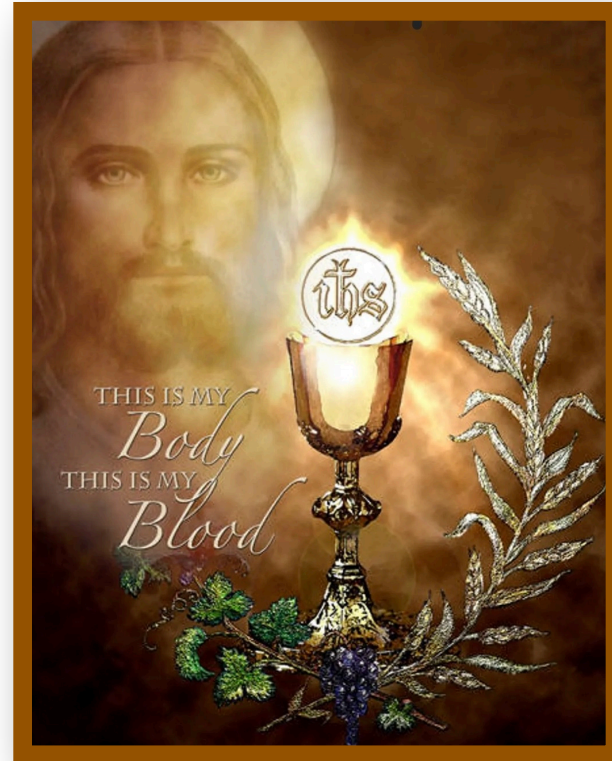

Second Collection

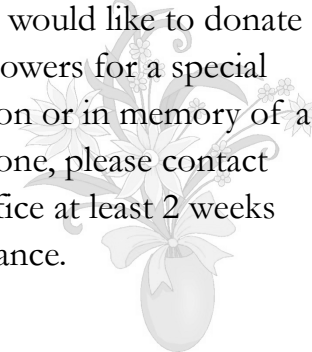
