The old Mass settings cards will be removed from the pews and the new music can be found in the green hymnal #185-194. We have used this music before and it may be familiar to you.

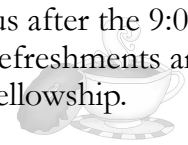
Potluck Luncheons
