

# Share God's Love

The Diocesan Council of Catholic Women is coordinating a Food Packing Event with Cross Catholic Outreach to pack 50,000 meals for families in developing countries. The event will take place on Saturday, August 12. We are inviting everyone who is willing and able to join us on that day as we put our faith into action by sharing God's love with people who are hungry.

- We will raise \$16,500 to pack 50,000 meals @ \$.33 per meal. Those who volunteer to help are not required to donate and those who donate are not required to help - we need both donors and helpers.
- We will need about 150-200 volunteers. We want to engage as many people as possible: schools, youth groups, young adults, men's groups (we need muscle), women's groups, old, young, families ...
- Bishop Bill is the first volunteer to sign up!
- We will pack the food at the Walton County Fairgrounds in DeFuniak Springs; it is a central location near I-10

that will be convenient for those traveling some distance.

- Volunteers can sign up for one of two shifts (or both): 10:00-12:00 or 12:30-2:30. No need to provide lunch with this schedule – we will encourage fasting in solidarity with the people we are serving.
- Cross Catholic brings everything we need, sets up, directs, cleans up, and a truck takes the food that will be shipped to Central America and/or the Caribbean.
- This event is a great community-builder for the diocese as well as an opportunity for us to give of ourselves to serve those in deepest poverty. Missionaries in Central America and the Caribbean are begging for these shipments of food. Thank you for helping us help others.
