Catholic Sharing Appeal

This weekend is presentation Sunday for CSA. Parishes rely on donations from parishioners to operate. The diocese does not have these funds. CSA fulfills the needs for funds at the diocesan level for expenses that extend past the parish or regional responsibilities. We rely on our Diocese on a daily basis. Each parish is given a pledge goal. Parish offertory is one of the principal factors in determining a proportionate amount of support from each parish. If parishioners do not meet the pledge goal the parish still must pay the balance not collected.

However if the parish collects above the pledge goal the amount over is given back to that parish. By giving funds through CSA parishioners assist our Bishop and Pastor in carrying out a threefold mission of the Church: teaching, serving and worshipping. The diocese will be mailing brochures and pledge cards to all active parishioners on February 2. We will also have some at each entrance of the church. This year's pledge goal is \$28,225.00 compared to last year's goal of \$25,460.96. That is an increase of \$2,764.04 with only 33 parish families contributing last year. Please prayerfully consider how much you can contribute.
